1.0 OPERATIONS

1.1 CONVENE COMMISSIONERS MEETING. The meeting was convened at 10:01 a.m.

Bids were to be opened for Bunker Renovation at White Deer Golf Course, but none were received.

2.0 ACTION ITEMS

- 2.1 APPROVE CASH REQUIREMENTS REPORT. A motion by Mr. McKernan and seconded by Mr. Mirabito and passed (3-0), approved accounts payable cash requirement report through October 19, 2016, for payment on October 12, 2016.
- Mr. Mussare commented on the amounts that are received for payment of county taxes.
- 2.2 APPROVE GRANT APPLICATION TO NRA FOUNDATION. A motion by Mr. Mussare and seconded by Mr. Mirabito and passed (3-0), approved grant application to the NRA Foundation in the amount of \$12,500.
- Ms. Toon said this is for training for APO, DRO, and sheriff deputies.

- Mr. Mussare said he is unsure why Mr. Mirabito brought her being female up as an issue.

 - Mr. McKernan announced this week as fire prevention week in Lycoming County.
