1.0 OPERATIONS

- 1.1 CONVENE COMMISSIONERS MEETING. Mr. Wheeland convened the Commissioners Meeting 10:01 a.m.
- 1.2 APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS. A motion by Mr. Larson and seconded by Mr. Mussare and passed (3-0), approved the minutes of the previous meeting as they are recorded.
- 1.3 RECEIVE PUBLIC COMMENTS (AGENDA ITEMS ONLY). Mr. Wheeland opened the floor to public comment on agenda items only, and none were received.
 - Mr. Wheeland recessed the Commissioners' Meeting at 10:01 a.m.

Public Hearing for Zoning Map Amendments.

- Mr. Wheeland opened the public hearing for the Zoning Map Amendment.
- Solicitor Smith reviewed the rules of conduct for a public hearing.
- Kurt Hausammann, Director of Planning and Community Development explained the 4 map amendments.
- Mr. Hausammann added the advantage of being in the Zoning partnership is that it relieves the municipality of the zoning requirements, and the county takes this on.

- The floor was opened to public comment and the following were received:
- Sherry Gray of Ralston/McIntyre Township stated her concerns with the change there.
- James Gray dittoed Sherry's comments.
- Sharon Broadbent of McIntyre is a homeowner with a business. She said the intentions are not clear for the property that is being re-zoned.
- Max Mechly of McIntyre Township represents 45 members of the community and he wants to know if the rezoning will increase the property owner's taxes. He also says the bridge and the playground are both an issue.
- J. Michael Wiley, representing Brooks Lumber Company explained this is to correct a previous mistake.
- Mr. William Brooks, III explained that he was not aware his property was rezoned. It used to be heavy industrial property. He is not sure what his plans are. He does not want to do anything detrimental to the community. As the property is currently zoned, it is worthless.
- Al Boyer, supervisor of McIntyre Township feels the property was zoned incorrectly in the 1990's. The vote of the supervisors for this change was 2-1. A fence around the playground was discussed.
- Kurt Hausammann agreed it was an error in the 1990's, and this would be correcting that.
- Mr. Mussare emphasized it is your community, your property and you have rights.
- Sharon Broadbent stated she has a petition opposing this, and that the supervisors are not listening to the residents.
- Kurt Hausammann explained that all advertising and posting requirements were met.
- Robert Shearer of McHenry Township is afraid of changing the zoning there to rural center and neighborhood preservation. He is concerned that his rights are being taken away. He asked for clarification on uses.
- David Hines, Zoning Administrator explained the uses and definitions.
- Don Price, supervisor of McHenry Township, wants to protect the areas from parking trucks, and wants to protect the roads. The vote of the supervisors in favor of this was 3-0.
- Mr. Wheeland explained that all property owners suffer if there is no zoning.
- Mr. Hausammann said that health, safety, and welfare are the reasons for zoning.
- Mr. Wheeland closed the hearing at 11:02 a.m.
