

Judge Richard A. Gray is a 1970 graduate of the Pennsylvania State University, *magna cum laude*, and a 1975 graduate of the Dickinson School of Law. After law school, Judge Gray was a law clerk to the late James S. Bowman, President Judge of the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania. From 1976-2003, Judge Gray practiced law primarily in the areas of automobile law, professional liability and products liability. In 2003, he was elected Judge for Lycoming County and was the Family Court Judge since taking the bench in 2004 until January 2008. During 2006 and 2007, he handled criminal cases and since the beginning of 2008 has been given responsibility for civil litigation.
