Ask attendant for the best way to recycle newspaper</p>	<p>MAGAZINES Keep separate from newspaper. Include magazines, catalogs, glossy newspaper inserts & phone books. Put in the roll-off loose. Remove string & plastic bags.</p>	<p>OFFICE PAPER Copy, typing, colored copy, writing and computer paper only. Remove from bags & boxes when you put in roll-off</p>	<p>PAPERBOARD & CHIP BOARD These are your cereal type boxes. Include paper towel rolls, food boxes, JUNK MAIL and paperboard. Remove all food, plastic and non-paper parts. Do not include dirty, oily or wet boxes.</p>	<p>STEEL & TIN CANS We are accepting clean cans and metal lids. You do not need to remove the labels.</p>	<p>ALUMINUM Accepting aluminum cans. (Rinse cans) Check at your drop-off to see if they accept FOIL</p>	<p>CLEAR, GREEN & BROWN GLASS Accepting glass bottles & Jars ONLY. Clean glass & separate colors. NO Plates NO Window Glass, NO Pyrex, NO Light Bulbs, NO Drinking Glasses, NO CANDLE JARS</p>	<p>PLASTIC #1 Pet & #2 HDPE Accepting #1 & #2 plastic bottle & jars only. Caps can be left on at most drop-offs. NO DELI CONTAINERS, NO BUCKETS, NO DISHES.....</p>
