The Department of Veterans Affairs' (VA) has founded a National Call Center for Homeless Veterans hotline to ensure that homeless Veterans or Veterans at-risk for homelessness have free, 24/7 access to trained counselors. The hotline is intended to assist homeless Veterans and their families, VA Medical Centers, federal, state and local partners, community agencies, service providers and others in the community. What will happen when I call?

- > Family members and non-VA providers calling on behalf of a homeless Veteran will be provided with information regarding the homeless programs and services available.
- ➤ Contact information will be requested so staff may follow-up.

- 2. The Military Day Student Program— Each Senator and Representative can refer as many military Veterans/ Guardsman or Reservists to attend Valley Forge as independent day students. In most cases existing government benefits will pay 100% of the cost of attendance.

Students should apply directly to their regional offices of their state Senator or Representative for a legislative appointment. Their committee will review all the applications, and will select one student each year to represent their district at Valley Forge Military College.
