### Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters Lycoming County November 3, 2020 General Election

This is an official notice of an election to be conducted on November 3, 2020 in Lycoming County. Military and overseas electors may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at [www.votespa.com](http://www.votespa.com), [www.fvap.gov](http://www.fvap.gov), or the Voter Services website at [www.lyco.org/vote](http://www.lyco.org/vote). You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (570) 320-2117 or by email to [voterservices@lyco.org](mailto:voterservices@lyco.org).

Military and overseas electors may request an absentee ballot at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the *Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot* (FWAB), available at [www.votespa.com](http://www.votespa.com), [www.fvap.gov](http://www.fvap.gov), or the Voter Services website at [www.lyco.org/vote](http://www.lyco.org/vote). Military electors may use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

The FWAB can be used to vote for ALL federal, state, and local offices and ballot initiatives.

To vote, refer to the instructions and page 3 of the FWAB application.

To vote for federal offices (President, U.S. Senator, or U.S. Representative in Congress), write in the name of the candidate of your choice in the space provided on the FWAB.

To vote for state offices, local offices, or ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation, or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum question write YES or NO.

**Liquor License Ballot Question**

Do you favor the granting of liquor licenses for the sale of liquor in the Township of Cogan House?

**Plain English Statement**

The purpose of the ballot question is to determine whether the electors of Cogan House Township favor allowing the granting of liquor licenses by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board for the sale of liquor in Cogan House Township.

The limitation and final effect of the ballot question is that if a majority of the votes cast are "Yes" votes, electors would be approving the potential granting of licenses by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to allow the sale of liquor in Cogan House Township; whereas, if the number of "No" votes is equal to or greater than the number of "Yes" votes then the granting of liquor licenses in Cogan House Township would not be permitted.

## City of Williamsport Polling Places

The number of wards in the City of Williamsport has been consolidated to 13. Ward lines and polling places throughout the city have been affected. All voters whose ward numbers or polling places changed as a result of the redistricting were mailed new voter registration cards that include updated ward number and polling place information.
