# **1.0 OPERATIONS**

- <u>1.1 CONVENE COMMISSIONERS MEETING.</u> Mr. McKernan convened the Commissioners Meeting 10:07 a.m.
- <u>1.2 APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS.</u> A motion by Mr. Mussare and seconded by Mr. Mirabito and passed (3-0), approved the minutes of September 5<sup>th</sup> as they are recorded.
- <u>1.3 RECEIVE PUBLIC COMMENTS (AGENDA ITEMS ONLY).</u> Mr. McKernan opened the floor to public comment on agenda items only, and none were received.

# 2.0 ACTION ITEMS

- 2.1 PROCLAIM SUICIDE PREVENTION AND AWARENESS MONTH. A motion by Mr. Mirabito and seconded by Mr. Mussare and passed (2-0), proclaimed September, 2017, as Suicide Prevention and Awareness Month in Lycoming County.
- Bob Minier, veteran spoke about the Veteran's Crisis Line at 800-273-8255.
- Joe Miller, co-chair of the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of American Foundation for Suicide Prevention spoke about <u>www.lifeisworthliving.org</u>. He went over suicide statistics.
- Tim Mahoney from Lycoming County Health Improvement Coalition shared the design of a shirt that the student organization developed to help with suicide prevention.

- Mr. Mussare talked about Kevin Heines jumping form the Golden Gate Bridge and living.
- Mr. McKernan talked about Carol Sides and her involvement with the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI).
- 2.2 APPROVE FLOOD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE GRANT. A motion by Mr. Mirabito and seconded by Mr. Mussare and passed (2-0), approved 2016 Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant from PEMA in the amount of \$2,681,750. Josh Schnitzlein explained this is for 11 properties.
- 2.3 APPROVE PURCHASE FROM PRODUCTIVITY PRODUCTS AND SERVICES. A motion by Mr. Mirabito and seconded by Mr. Mussare and passed (2-0), approved purchase from Productivity Products and Services, Inc. of a Global Navigation Satellite Guided Construction System with accessories in the amount of \$254,279.20 off of COSTARS contract.
- 2.4 APPROVE PURCHASE FROM TOWER SERVICES UNLIMITED. A motion by Mr. Mirabito and seconded by Mr. Mussare and passed (2-0), approved purchase from Tower Services Unlimited for Tower Site Grounding Enhancement Project in the amount of \$11,160.
- Mr. Mussare voiced his concern with the state budget and the incorrect proposal being discussed at that level for the proposed use of 9-1-1 fees for items not directly related to 9-1-1 and public safety. He urged constituents to call their legislators.
