Species	Size	Description
Eastern White Pine	8-12"	Evergreen: Has soft, long needles. Grows rapidly in a variety of soil and prefers sun. Extremely hardy. Grows to 6 feet in 8-11 years. Max 100ft.
Colorado Blue Spruce	5-10"	Evergreen: Has blue-green color. Can grow 50-75 feet. Good windbreak. Popular Christmas tree. Grow to six feet in 10-12 years. Max 100ft
Norway Spruce	8-12"	Evergreen: Highly valued ornamental and timber tree. One of the best conifers for shelters and windbreaks. Fast growing Max.75-80
Concolor Fir	6-12"	Evergreen: Concolor is one of the most beautiful and easy to care for evergreens. One of the best Christmas trees. Grows to 100 feet
Chestnut Oak	12-18"	Can tolerate poor, rocky soil. Acorns are a dark brown with a very sweet taste. Good wildlife tree for squirrels and deer. Max 60ft
Black Cherry	6-12"	Highly prized in furniture making and is an excellent fire wood. Fruit provides food for wildlife. Grows to 60ft
Sugar Maple	6-12"	A landscape standout. Medium to dark-green leaves turn yellow, burnt orange or red in fall. Tolerates shade, likes a well-drained, moderately moist, fertile soil. Grows to 60' to 75'
American Persimmon	10-15"	Most ripe American persimmons are used in jams and jellies. Showy fall color and provide wildlife food.
Silky Dogwood	12-18"	Attractive shrub with small white flowers and produces a blue-black berries in mid-summer. Moist soils but can adapt to drier. Grows to 10'
Winterberry Holly	12-18"	Attractive shrub. Provides red berries through the winter. Good wetland plant. Likes acidic soil. Should plant several for good pollination.
American Hazelnut	6-12"	Easy to grow native shrub that produces edible nuts in late summer, excellent hedgerow plant, and is highly attractive to wildlife.
APPLE* Aztec Fuji	4-6 Ft. Semi-Dwarf	Full-colored, blush-type that harvests late season with standard Fuji. ... The tree is healthy and vigorous, and the fruit exhibits the traditional, sweet flavor of Fuji.
APPLE* Cardinal Cortland	4-6 Ft. Semi-Dwarf	Small Semi- Dwarf, Won't turn brown! This productive tree bears gorgeous ruby red apples. Also perfect for pies and cider. Cold-hardy. Ripens in mid Sept.
APPLE* Buckeye Gala	4-6 Ft. Semi-Dwarf	Semi-Dwarf, Fruit is bright red with distinctively dark red stripes. Great for fresh-eating, cooking, and baking. Keeps up to 7 months. Ripens mid-late August.
BLUEBERRIES* Earliblue	12-18"	This variety produces large, light blue and firm berries, which ripen in tight clusters. mild sweet. Berries are resistant to cracking. Good cold tolerance.
BLUEBERRIES* Bluetta	12-18"	Good for cooler climates it blooms a little later, yet ripens early. It is very productive, slightly dark and medium-sized, with a unique wild flavor.
RASPBERRIES Black Jewel	Trsp	Large, firm berries of superior quality. Vigorous, consistently productive, and resistant to anthracnose and widely adapted. Excellent flavor.
RASPBERRIES Red Everbearing	Trsp	Very high quality. Plants are very vigorous and erect. Fruit has excellent flavor and can be used for both canning and/or freezing. Plants produce moderate crops in the summer with extra crops of big berries in the fall.

**Apples and Blueberries require another variety for pollination.*
