TIMELINE FOR CIVIL CASE SCHEDULING ORDERS:

At the close of pleadings, a Scheduling Order will be entered which allows a discovery period of:

- 4 months for fast-track (like mortgage foreclosure or credit card collection)
- 9 months for a regular case (like motor vehicle accident or other debt collection)
- 12 months for a complex case (like slip and fall or quiet title)
- 14 months for a medical malpractice

and these intervals: Example:
