# Proposed Reestablishment Plan for the Magisterial District Courts of the 29<sup>th</sup> Judicial District, Lycoming County, Pennsylvania

As required pursuant to constitutional and statutory provisions, reestablishment is a process by which the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania reviews the boundaries of the magisterial districts within each judicial district, except the First Judicial District—Philadelphia County. This review is undertaken in each year following the official reporting of the decennial census figures. The review is based upon reported population figures, case types and filings, case weights, geographic positioning of the magisterial districts, and related issues.

To inform you of this process, and to offer the opportunity for public comment to the proposal, copies of the proposed plan are available for review at the Lycoming County Courthouse, 48 West Third Street, Williamsport, PA 17701, in the Office of the District Court Administrator and in the Law Library. Copies are also available at each Magisterial District Court and the James V. Brown Library, 19 East Fourth Street, Williamsport, PA 17701. # Summary of Proposed Changes to the Magisterial District Courts of the 29<sup>th</sup> Judicial District, Lycoming County, Pennsylvania

The 29<sup>th</sup> Judicial District of Pennsylvania is comprised of six magisterial districts. In order to better balance the workloads within those magisterial districts, the following changes in the magisterial district boundaries are being proposed:

- 1) Effective January 1, 2023, Magisterial District 29-1-02 will include Williamsport wards 8 and 9 in addition to the wards within the district's existing boundaries—wards 1, 2, 10, 11, 12, and 13.
- 2) Effective January 1, 2023, Magisterial District 29-1-01 will exclude Williamsport wards 8 and 9. Consequently, Magisterial District 29-1-01 will include wards 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7.
- 3) Effective January 1, 2024, Magisterial District 29-3-04 will include Loyalsock Township precincts 1, 2, and 6 in addition to the municipalities within the district's existing boundaries—Armstrong Township, Cogan House Township, Duboistown Borough, Hepburn Township, Jackson Township, Lewis Township, Loyalsock Township precinct 3, Lycoming Township, McIntyre Township, McNett Township, Old Lycoming Township, and Susquehanna Township. The effective date of this realignment is delayed until January 1, 2024, because the magisterial district judge in Magisterial District 29-3-04 is assisting Magisterial District 29-3-03 during a two-year judicial vacancy (2022 and 2023).
- 4) Effective January 1, 2024, Magisterial District 29-3-02 will exclude Loyalsock Township precincts 1, 2, and 6. Consequently, Magisterial District 29-3-02 will include Cascade Township; Eldred Township; Fairfield Township; Gamble Township; Loyalsock Township precincts 4, 5, and 7; Montoursville Borough; Plunketts Creek Township; South Williamsport Borough; and Upper Fairfield Township. The effective date of this realignment is delayed until January 1, 2024, because the magisterial district judge in Magisterial District 29-3-04 is assisting Magisterial District 29-3-03 during a two-year judicial vacancy (2022 and 2023).

Magisterial Districts 29-3-01 and 29-3-03 will be reestablished with their current jurisdictional boundaries. Lycoming County is at the lower end of the caseload range when compared to other judicial districts in its class; however, Lycoming County is geographically the largest county in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. If a magisterial district were to be eliminated, the residents of Lycoming County would be denied adequate access to the courts due to the distance they would be required to travel to court.
