

Expectation: Implementability



PRPs must demonstrate
financial feasibility



For each permit-term BMP:


Provide:

- BMP identifier (name)
- Sponsor(s) and or Partner(s)
- Funding source(s)

Optional PRP Content


- Design and Construction Costs
- Current Status
- Milestone Dates



All Net Load Reductions Count

Even if they are free to the permittee

- Developer "contributions"
- Voluntary retrofits
- Public or private property

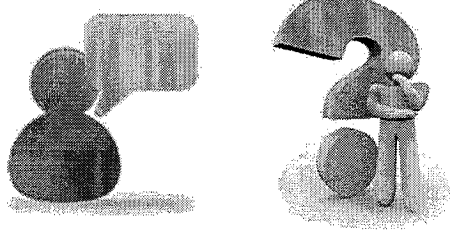
