## Dear Municipal or Civic leader:

Lycoming County is seeking projects that enhance water quality to include in its application to the PA Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for Countywide Action Plan (CAP) funds. Applications are due to the County on **Tuesday, September 30**<sup>th</sup>.

Eligible applicants include: Municipalities, Government entities, Non-profit and Community Organizations, Educational Institutions. Individuals are not eligible to apply. Projects must be located in Lycoming County.

Water quality improvements consist of best management practices (BMPs) that remedy stormwater runoff from urban and agricultural sources and/or stabilize unstable stream systems. Projects must demonstrate the ability to reduce phosphorous, nitrogen, and sediment pollution in our waterways.
