Lycoming County, Pennsylvania Five Shelters RFP – Questions and Answers Series #1

Dear Proposer,

Listed below are the answers to the questions received as of 4:00 P.M. EST, January 29, 2021.

Question 1: In Section 5, Scope of Work/Technical Specifications, III Part A, paragraph S on lighting, IV Part B, paragraph S on lighting, and V Part C, paragraph N on lighting: the light count for LED interior lights would be more in line with eight (8) for a 12' x 20', six (6) for a 12' x 16' and 4 for a 10' x 12' so as not to exceed energy efficiency codes. Is that OK?

Answer 1: Yes.

Question 2: In Section 5, Scope of Work/Technical Specifications, III Part A, paragraph Q on environmental system, IV Part B, paragraph Q on environmental system, and V Part C, paragraph L on environmental system: HVAC for the 12' x 20 and 12' x 16' shelters are 31,200 BTU, which would mean a 36,000 BTU or 3 ton HVAC units. Is that your intention?

Answer 2: Yes.

Question 3: In Section 5, Scope of Work/Technical Specifications, III Part A, paragraph Q on environmental system, IV Part B, paragraph Q on environmental system, and V Part C, paragraph L on environmental system: in lieu of thermostat, do you mean lead lag controller?

Answer 3: Yes.

Question 4: In Section 5, Scope of Work/Technical Specifications, III Part A, paragraph T on cable ladder, IV Part B, paragraph T on cable ladder, and V Part C, paragraph O on cable ladder: for the cable trays on 12'x20' and 12'x16' our interpretation is 46' total linear feet of 18" cable tray, and on a 10'x12' shelter our interpretation is 28' total linear feet of 18" cable tray.

Answer 4: Correct.

Question 5: Commercial grade ionization smoke detectors have been discontinued. Is a photelectric smoke detector OK?

Answer 5: Yes.

Question 6: The total twist lock count of six (6) 120V 30 Amp and six (6) 240V 30 Amp on the 10' x 12' shelters seems to be in excess of the number of racks that could fit in that 10' x 12' shelter option. Is this the twist lock count you want on the 10' x 12' shelter option?

Answer 6: Yes. The twist lock count is required. Please figure on mounting receptacle housings back-to-back and on minimal spacing if necessary.

Question 7: The convenience outlet count on the 10'x12' of eight (8) seems high. Would you prefer six (6)?

Answer 7: Six receptacles are acceptable for the 10'x12' shelters.
