## Safety and Operating Tips

Please come to a complete stop at each Stop sign located on RMS facilities including those preceding each set of scales.

Preference may be given to haulers for admittance to the inbound scale, however, haulers are to Yield to self-dump traffic as directed by LCRMS staff, or to maintain safe and courteous conditions.

When waste is still left in the container after disposal has been completed, the driver will move the vehicle to the designated clean-out area and remove the debris at that location only.

Drivers coming to the scale for their outbound weigh, may need to Yield to vehicles coming from the self-dump location.

Please wait in a first come, first served manner upon arrival at the active disposal site.

Please back into the active working face to get as close as possible to the edge of the pad before opening doors, unless otherwise directed by RMS staff.

## Wetlands Project

We recently completed work on the construction of a wetlands area located on the Callenberger Farm property. This wetland replacement (mitigation) project has created 1.57 acres of wetlands to compensate for proposed wetland impacts due to planned construction on the landfill site. In addition to cleaning, grubbing, grading and other

tasks, we also removed some seed bed material from an area near the recycling facility and relocated it to the new wetlands area. RMS personnel completed this work with the help of wetlands expert, Steve Bason of Cedar Run Environmental Services, Inc. and the engineering firm of Cummings & Smith, Inc.



## For Your Information

**Line Painting** is being planned for the landfill and recycling complex. The painting is expected to be completed during operating hours on a Saturday this fall. Please be alert to changing traffic patterns during that project.

An increase in **disposal fees** at the landfill and transfer station will go into effect January 1, 2007. The amount of the increase has not been finalized yet as we are still in the review stage of the 2007 budget. The increase will be determined by November and notices will be posted at the

scale houses, and on our website ([www.lcrms.com](http://www.lcrms.com)). We will also send a notices in the mail.
