

Acceptable Materials at the Recycling Drop Off Locations



Plastic Containers

Kitchen, laundry, bath bottles and containers with numbers #1&2.
Rinse the inside, labels may be left on.

*No oil or anti-freeze containers, plastic bags/film, Styrofoam, laundry baskets, or plastic toys.
Do NOT Bag recyclables.*



Cans

Steel/Tin Cans, Aluminum Cans.
Rinse the inside, labels may be left on.



Glass

Glass Bottles and Jars.
Clear, Brown, and Green glass; blue glass may be recycled with Green glass.
Rinse the inside, labels may be left on, do not break glass.

*No glass drinking cups, Pyrex, ceramics, window glass, plate glass, mirrors, auto glass,
Earthen ware, pottery, or light bulbs.*



Cartons

Food and Beverage Cartons.
Cartons are available in two types, shelf-stable and refrigerated.
(Milk, Juice, Broth, and Soup Cartons)



Paper

ALL PAPER MUST BE DRY
Newspaper and Magazines - separate bundles
Mixed Papers - Junk Mail, including envelopes, papers from junk mail, glossy ads, office paper, notepaper
Cardboard - flattened cardboard (breakdown boxes) *No Styrofoam or packaging materials,
No waxed cardboard*
Chipboard - cereal boxes, soda cases, dry food boxes, paper towel rolls *No plastic or foil liners*
Composite Cans - Rigid cylindrical container whose body is made of layers of papers, ends with metal or plastic (i.e. Pringles cans, coffee cans)
Wrapping Paper/Cards - wrapping paper and greeting cards may be placed in the cardboard containers *No foil gift wrap*

(No hoses, wires, chains, or electronics)

Other Accepted Materials at LCRMS Landfill Location:

(447 Alexander Drive, Montgomery, PA 17752)

White Goods / Appliances:

- Appliances are accepted free of charge except those containing refrigerant
- Items containing refrigerant are accepted for a fee per unit at the Landfill and Transfer Station
- ** Exception: Dishwashers with a steel interior are recyclable, those with thermo-plastic interiors are not (they are considered trash)

Automobile Waste / Used Motor Oil:

- The Landfill accepts tires and batteries for recycling
- A fee is charged for tire recycling
- Used motor oil is also accepted in small volumes
- A listing of retailers and service stations who also accept used motor oil, filters, batteries, scrap metal and tires for recycling are as follows:

Electronic Devices:

- Following is accepted from Residents ONLY - TVs, Computers and Computer Peripherals (mice, keyboards, speakers, printers)
- Drop off containers are located at the Landfill and the Transfer Station

Wood Waste:

- Clean wood waste is accepted at the Landfill for a fee
- Acceptable wood: Non-pressure treated scrap lumber, unpainted wooden pallets and warehouse type skids, cable spools and marine grade plywood
