Election Day COVID-19 Information for Voters May 18, 2021 Municipal Primary

- All 81 voting precincts in Lycoming County are open from 7:00am-8:00pm. A list of Election Day polling places is available at www.lyco.org/vote.
- Voters who applied for an absentee or mail-in ballot may only vote in person by provisional ballot, unless they bring the official ballot and official return envelope to the polling place to be surrendered in order to vote by regular ballot. Absentee and mail-in voters may also hand-deliver their voted ballots to Voter Services at any time before the close of polls at 8:00pm.
- Absentee and mail-in ballots must be received by 8:00pm on Election Day.
- Expect lines during peak periods of 7am-9am, 12pm-2pm, and 4pm-6pm. Lines may extend outside some polling places due to social distancing. Voters should be prepared to wait in lines at times and should dress appropriately for weather conditions.
- Voters are asked to wear a mask in order to comply with current state health directives.
- Hand sanitizer is available at all polling places. Voters should apply hand sanitizer when entering and leaving the polling place.
- Although pens are available at all polling places, voters may bring their own pens. Black or blue ballpoint pens are preferred to ensure readable marks on the ballot.
- Please treat the poll workers with respect and kindness. They are making democracy work under challenging circumstances, and they are some of the county's finest public servants.
